Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the letter that was sent yesterday advising you of the **one** positive Covid 19 case in school, I am aware that some parents and carers may have additional questions or concerns.

I am writing to reassure you that we are operating in line with DfE guidelines and that all actions and decisions made are done so in line with direction from Public Health England.

Where pupils have been in direct contact with someone who has a positive test result, parents and carers will be contacted in person by myself or a member of the Senior Management Team. The wider school community will be made aware of the case but we are not in position to be able to share details.

Where pupils and staff are required to self-isolate, Public Health England have advised that this is 14 days from the last direct contact and not 14 days from the date of the test result.

We are all living and working through a difficult period at present and we recognise that emotions and anxieties are running high. However, we kindly ask that you contact school directly if you wish to discuss your concerns rather than posting these publically on social media.

I will continue to keep you updated in due course.
