

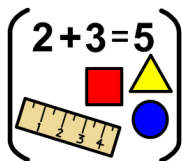


Tiger Class Autumn 2023 Newsletter

Theme: Movers and Shakers

Early Maths

This term during our Early Maths lessons we will be learning about Measurement in relation to length and height and also money. There will be a weekly focus on Number such as counting, recognition of digits and ordering, addition and subtraction. We will use Numicon.



Early English and Phonic Awareness

We will explore patterns on a page in poetry. Within Narrative we will explore Fantasy Worlds. Our Non Fiction will be instructions using recipes as our focus. We will offer a variety of activities to develop pencil grip and control and follow the Happy Handwriting scheme throughout the week. Phonic Awareness sessions will follow the Little Wandle SEND scheme.



Early Science

Our Early Science topic this term focuses on My Body learning about the names of main body parts and how to keep healthy.



Early Computing



This term we will be exploring how we use technology in relation to everyday use and for communicating in relation to counting.

Physical Development

PD for Autumn 1 will be dance. We will follow structured dance play lessons learning the actions and dance moves for action songs.



Early PSHE



In Early PSHE our topics are related to identifying and expressing feelings and managing strong feelings.

Creative

In DT we will design, make and evaluate a special box/container.

In Art we will investigate the work of Andy Warhol and create our own examples of his work.
