English

We have an exciting term planned, with lots of super learning opportunities that will continue to support, develop and enhance pupils' skills and knowledge. In the first half term we will be exploring Myths and Legends. Our author for our main text is Leo Timmer's. We will surprise the children with the title, it is very exciting!

For the second half of the term, we will firstly explore 'Shape Poetry,' and will produce our own wonderful creations using the super literacy skills that we have been learning. Our final English topic will be Non-Fiction, and will be "Instructions." This will coincide with our DT topic of creating a picture frame.

Eagle Class will continue to access daily Phonics lessons, through Little Wandle.

Maths

Autumn 1

The pupils will continue to develop their understanding of place value, counting, ordering and representing number. Pupils will also learn about Measurement, focusing on Length and Height.

Autumn 2

During the second half of the term, we will work on Addition and Subtraction. We will also continue to explore Money, with an emphasis on lots of practical learning opportunities.



Science

This term we will be investigating the Human Body. We will learn all about the organs and their functions. During the second half of the term we will learn about how to keep the different parts of our body healthy, both inside and outside.

PE –Eagle Class will explore how our bodies move by learning dance moves from a range of genres.

ICT – In our first half term we will learn about the history of the internet. We will learn about the different uses, and how to stay safe when using it. In the second half we will learn about data and how it is input onto pictograms and charts.

Music – Throughout our weekly lessons we will explore a range of musical instruction.

Art/DT

During Art this term, we shall be following our theme of explorers by learning about Gabby O Connor, an installation artist who creates sculptures based on her expeditions across the globe.



Our DT project will be to design, create and evaluate a Photo frame.

PSHE

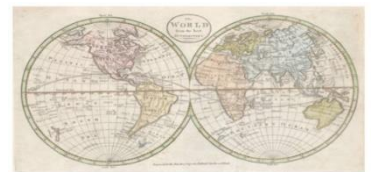
Firstly, we are going to learn about self-esteem. What is self esteem and why should we think about it? We will also learn about the impact of the words that we use, and how to be kind.
